CAMPAIGN GOES ON !

Lancaster City Council voted on 20th December 2017 to adopt the Local Plan, including the development of Bailrigg garden village. While this was a disappointment for us, this decision came as no real surprise and it most certainly doesn't mean that our campaign is finished. Rather it is just starting!

What comes next?

The crucial approval process of the Local Plan is just starting leading to examination of the plan by a Government appointed planning inspector.

What does the Planning Inspector do?

Consider written objections to the plan and carry out public hearings.

Evidence from around the country suggests that planning inspectors understand the technical issues involved and bring independent judgement to the plans they examine.

We cannot of course guarantee a successful outcome but are convinced that, with sound arguments and enough support, sensible amendments to the proposed local plan can be made.

So please do come to this CLOUD meeting and help to decide our way ahead.
